Glimpses of God from Glenn...

I was reading a devotion recently that was written by Mary Luti. In it she asked the question - Why? Why do so many Christians believe that in order for God to bestow a blessing on them, God had to remove it from someone else? Her context was the growing anger between some Christians and Jews - and the violence being directed toward Jews.

It is right and acceptable for us to ask this question. And we do ask this question, but we do so in a very different way. We ask, "Does God love us?"

Of course, we quickly answer, "Yes!" But within our thoughts, I believe there may be a sense that we believe God doesn't love the Christians who spew hate and anger, violence and approval of that violence. With gratitude (and maybe superiority) we say, "Just wait until they come face-to-face with God and have to explain their words and actions." We are so much better than they are because we don't spew hatred using God's name. This thought puts us in a difficult spot. God calls us to love, but how do we love someone who doesn't love? Can we love someone who hates...just about everyone who is not like him or herself - the liberal, the gay, the Jew, the Catholic, the feminist, the transgender, the peacemaker...the list goes on and on.

One of the people who responded to Ms. Luti was identified as "M S". She added the following, a wonderful comment, to the discussion:

"This is profoundly relevant for our cultural and political struggles of today - not just for the Jewish/Christian dichotomy and relationship, but for every other either/or relationship or bias we tend to manufacture consciously or unconsciously where we humans just seem to crave or demand hierarchy. And God just consistently says 'Both, my children.' Women AND Men; blacks AND whites AND brown AND yellow AND polka dots; LGBTQ AND Straight; white feminists AND black feminists; the list is endless. God's love is not a game of mathematics, and God and Paul and Jesus and all the other examples from our biblical heritage are trying to teach us that. Only when we realize that God bestows blessings equally and completely and without taking from one when bestowing another, will we who are made in God's image learn that we will realize those blessings more completely as a society if we do the same."

I am also reminded that I love my children. When my second child was born, I did not diminish my love for my first child. When my third child was

born, I did not diminish my love for my other two children. Love is not a limited quantity. The more you love...the more love there is!

Remember - you are loved and blessed...and so is the person who is next to you - in your neighborhood, in the elevator, in your work place. God's child may even be in the car that just cut you off, or the person who is spewing hate. When we offer an extravagant welcome, it does mean to everyone...period.

Ms. Luti ended her devotion with the following prayer. May it be true for you as well.

"Faithful One, forgive us. We have been rivals for blessings, wanting the most and best for ourselves. But when you bestow a blessing, it is forever. If you bestow a second, you don't withdraw the first. If one shines, the others do not dim. And there are more blessings in your hand than stars in the starry sky." AMEN.
